Director and Editor

Tokyo Cowboys is a production team in Tokyo, Japan. I joined the team in 2019 to codirect and co-edit the Amazon Prime TV series "Benza English" which is now streaming in over 70 countries. In 2020 we produced the short film "I Just Wanted to See You" – written and directed by me - which is now screening at film festivals. Also as part of the

team, I have worked on editing promotional materials for other projects, such as "The Benza RPG" and am currently directing and editing an unannounced TV project.

Independent Filmmaker and Screenwriter, 2012 – Current

After graduating from university, I have been working freelance in both England and Japan as a filmmaker and screenwriter. I've found success working on both personal projects and for multiple clients. I've worked on a wide range of projects, from corporate videos to comedy skits, music videos and drama films.

In 2018, I produced the short film One Step. The film has been a huge success, with 17 worldwide festival screenings and winning four awards, including best short film and best drama. The screenplay – which I wrote myself – was also nominated for a best original screenplay award. The film is now available worldwide on Amazon Prime Video and has now had over 10,000 unique streams.
